Limpenhoe Village War Memorial

Autumn 2013 found a group of local villagers contemplating the state of the First World War memorial in Limpenhoe churchyard. Something had to be done! Five months on and with the full support of churchwarden Michael Brook, plans are advancing to mark the centenary of the outbreak of the 1914-18 war. Colin Smith, a much respected and well known monumental mason, has accepted the task of renovating the Cornish stone memorial which needs setting upright, cleaning and repainting. Six villagers have volunteered to each take one of the six names detailed on the stone and research the history of these brave men. We hope this research will enable us to locate their relatives and invite them to a Rededication Service during Open Churches

Week in August 2014. This will be followed by afternoon tea in the gardens of the Old Rectory by kind invitation of the new owners.

We would be delighted to hear from anyone who has any personal knowledge of the men who died so this can be included in the Remembrance booklet. When do we get a new Priest? We wish we could tell you! Normally we would have been advertising for one by now, but just before Christmas the Bishop of Thetford and Archdeacon of Norfolk had a meeting with the churchwardens and representatives of the parishes to discuss whether the Benefice should be reorganised. This is because, as we cannot afford to pay enough Benefice Share to cover the costs of a full time minister, other options are being looked at. They suggested that the Benefice might be split, 2 parishes going to join Acle and the rest forming a smaller group with a part-time priest. As we have all been working very closely together as a Benefice, the churchwardens did not like this idea and so counter proposals were made which the Bishop and Archdeacon are considering.
