7. General Parish Issues

a) Robert Beadle asked the district councillor why the parish council was no longer notified of planning decisions unless the decision was the opposite to the council's recommendation. Cllr Proctor agreed to make enquiries and report back.

b) It was noted that boat refuse was not collected from Cantley Staithe. Cllr Proctor agreed to investigate whether this could be done, as the southern rivers were being promoted by the Broads Authority in a widening of tourism in the Broads area.

c) It was noted that progress was being made with the provision of fibreoptic broadband to Cantley.
