Chairman's Report

The composition of the Parish Council has had a number of changes during the year. We were sad to lose the services of Kirstin Saunders as our clerk but are very pleased to welcome Catherine Moore as our new clerk. We were also sorry to receive the resignation of Nigel Tuck. Dot Machin had the honour of becoming vice-chairman and the vacancy for councillor was soon filled by the welcome return of Richard Attwood to the council.

Cantley Village sign is now standing having been decapitated by a car. The insurance and excess have been successfully claimed. The affordable housing has moved forward. Planning permission was granted for the Station Road site. A fence has appeared around this site and we await the widening of the road and the installation of a central refuge.

The Limpenhoe land swap continues. We have now applied for planning permission for change of use of the new site. We have also passed a formal resolution to proceed with the project to de-register the old site, carry out a land swap and then register the new site as Village Green (subject to planning permission and grant funding).

Keith Simpson, our local MP, visited one of our meetings. This was well attended and a lively discussion ensued. I am sure everyone who came enjoyed the evening.

We are planning to install a vehicle activated flashing sign on the approach to the junction of School Lane and the sharp bend in Manor Road. We had recently been successful in obtaining grant funding for 50% of the cost but needed to find the other half before going ahead. We are now pleased to say that we have just had confirmation that the other half will come from the factory A106 money set aside for road improvements. Hopefully this will occur in the next twelve months.

The Parish Council are responsible for the provision and maintenance of the grit bins and dog bins in the village, as well as the notice boards and two seats. To this end we have now introduced a four monthly Health and Safety inspection.

We are no longer part of a Local Authority cluster.

Our monthly meetings, parish newsletter, and other normal activities have continued as usual, except for a small change in our Annual Parish Council meeting which will now form part of our normal May meeting, rather than as a separate meeting preceding this meeting.

I would like to thank all the parish councillors and the clerk for their help and assistance through the year. I would also like to thank the members of the public who regularly attend.
